





Materials:

Basic Sewing supplies, 14 small buttons, fusible interfacing, polyfill

Instructions:

Cut out 2 sets of pieces leaving 1/4"+ seam allowance on all sides. Cut a single piece of fusible interfacing for every pattern piece leaving no seam allowance (cut only one set of front legs, one back, etc). Iron interfacing to wrong side of 'day' pattern pieces being careful to follow directions on package. Pin and then sew reverse pieces together right side in, leaving an opening to turn inside out. Clip curves to add ease (being careful not to cut through your stitches). Turn inside out. (Important: The tail is very thin, I recommend stitching the entire tail by hand, wrong sides together, gently pressing edges in as you sew). Using polyfill gently stuff body and legs. Sew up open edges with slip stitch. Sew along edges of wings and tail 1/8" all the way around with a straight stitch to strengthen shape. Locate matching points and sew limbs to main body with small buttons, creating 7 button joints. Pose and enjoy!

Not recommended for children under age 3. Small parts pose a potential choking hazard.
